

## Presentation of the Warlander, Warlander Sport Horse and Handlers



## Show Classes & Assessment

A well-bred Warlander and Warlander Sport Horse is a luxurious horse commonly displaying a lot of hair and a naturally glossy, fine coat. It is preferred that horses are shown naturally with mane and tail free to make the most of these qualities.

The horse must be sufficiently muscled over the top line, be sound and clean and have it's hooves in good order.

Trimming of whiskers is strictly prohibited, however a conservative 'tidy up' of ears, jowls and feathers on the legs is permitted and hooves can be oiled / painted. Under no circumstances are coat colours to be altered by artificial means.

## Dressage and Sport Events

Depending on the length of the mane and tail, we suggest braiding or plaiting for sport events for safety reasons however, check with your governing sport body (rules may differ country to country) on their presentation requirements prior to events.

## The handler/s

We do not want to detract from the horse and prefer the handler/s are attired in a clean, tidy manner such as well fitting black pants and white shirt and for colder climates add a black blazer with suitable and safe footwear for running.

Alternatively English riding attire or a dress or skirt / top combination and footwear suitable for safety is allowed.
