

ACCEPTED RATIOS FOR WARLANDER HORSES



First-generation Warlander (F1) horses are a 50/50% cross with either dam or sire being one of the purebred base breeds

Second generation (F2) and subsequent generations of Warlander horses can be bred as follows:

- 1: Warlander (50%/50%) x 100% Friesian or 100% Iberian RATIO = 75% 25%
- 2: Warlander (50%/50%) x Warlander (50%/50%) RATIO = 50% 50%
- 3: Warlander (75% Friesian/25% Iberian) x 100% Iberian RATIO = 37.5% 62.5%
- 4: Warlander (25% Friesian/75% Iberian) x 100% Friesian RATIO = 62.5% 37.5%
- 5: Warlander (50%/50%) x Warlander (75%/25% RATIO = 62.5% 37.5%
- 6: Warlander (75%/25%) x Warlander (75%/25%) RATIO =75% 25% 7
- 7: Warlander (75%/25%) x Warlander (25%/75%) RATIO = 50% 50%
